WHAT?

- Each chapter will participate in a piece of artwork creativity! You need to work together to produce a piece of artwork that relates to the six themes of Arise Arjuna.
- The artwork should then be brought to the Arise Arjuna national event and will be on display to everyone that attends the event.
- The artwork should also have a blurb explaining what the six themes mean to them, why they're important, what their chapter is doing to promote them etc.

WHY?

- It can have a great blend of learning, active participation, fun and creativeness
- Members learn while having fun...what more do you want!

HOW?

- Use a variety of materials. E.g.:
 - o Papier mache
 - o Rice
 - o Poster Paint
 - o Recycled material
- Use a variety of styles. E.g.:
 - o Large canvas painting
 - o Knitting/sewing
 - o 3D art
 - o Graphic design
 - o Collage
- Let your creative juices flow! Go wild with the innovation, imagination and creativeness.



WHO?

- Each Chapter will work as one, using their members and committee in a joint effort.
- This will also allow you all to mingle and get to know each other.

WHEN?

- Artwork can be done anytime up until the Arise Arjuna national event (Saturday 19th November).
- Plan a one-off event for your chapter members to get together one week and do it.
- Or even do it straight after a weekly worship event as a fun activity (be sure to promote this beforehand, too!)

WHERE?

- Can be done as a group activity in one of your SU rooms or even at the local Mandir.
